Annual assessment will increase by \$100, from \$150 to \$250, per household. An increase of up to \$100 was approved at member meeting March of 2015. The Association needs to build up contingency reserves, which are now approximately \$3000. The target goal is to accrue reserves equal to 1.5 times annual operating expense.

Policy & Procedures for RV Storage Discussion – New Guidelines are approved. New guidelines will be sent to members along with the budget and annual meeting information, scheduled for Jan 6, 2016, 6:00 PM, Redlands Community Center

Further discussion occurred around how to enforce new guidelines. The Board will make an initial assessment of current RVs to provide guidance to meet new guidelines. In the future the Board will only be involved if there is a complaint filed with our property managing company regarding storage of a particular RV, boat etc. Direction will be given to our Property Management firm to provide the Policy and Procedures, when requested by title companies for information re the HOA that the RV storage policy be conveyed.
